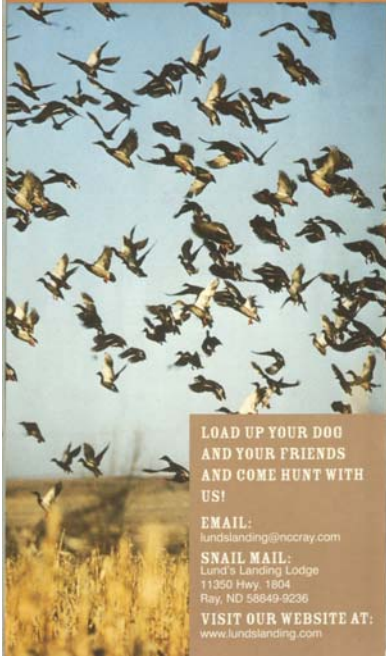

82 miles West on US Hwy. 2 to Williams County Hwy. 21 (105 Ave. NW), 1 mile West of the Junction of Highways 2 and 40 South of Tioga. Turn South on Williams County Hwy. 21 (105 Ave. NW) 10 miles to ND 1804. Turn West on Hwy. 1804. 12 miles turn South at Whitetail Bay to Lund's Landing Lodge.

### BISMARCK, NORTH DAKOTA (225 MILES)

North on US Hwy. 83, 96 miles to ND 23. West on ND 23 to New Town (79 miles). North on Hwy. 1804, 50 miles. Turn South at Whitetail Bay to Lund's Landing Lodge.

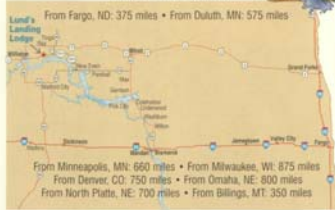

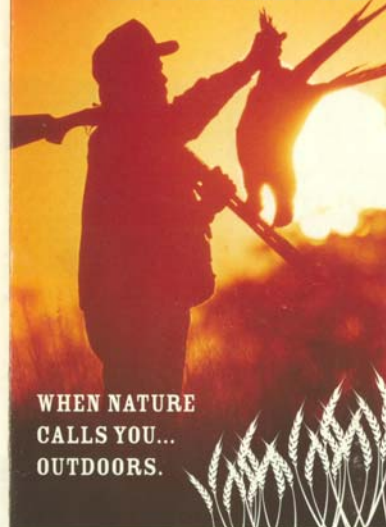

**THE CENTRAL FLYWAY**

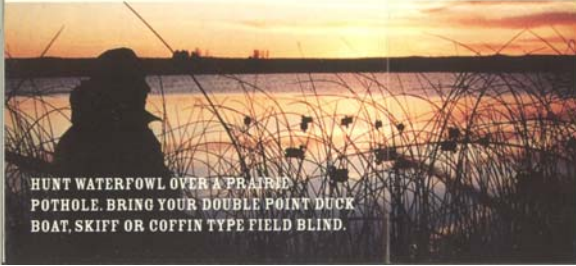
